

















CWE TSOs' information about the transfer to Core and CWE project closure

Shortly before Core DA FBMC go-live, CWE TSOs are closing the preparatory activities for this transfer and would like to provide an overall view about how the CWE project will merge into Core on different levels:

Regulatory implications

- With Core DA go-live, the CWE FBMC approval document will be replaced by the Core DA CCM
- The ACER decision on the Core ID CCM (published on 19/04) has introduced a broad range of provisions for the transitional period. Hence, there is no need to have in place a dedicated methodology for Intraday in the CWE region

Transfer CWE DACC Operational Process

- CWE DACC process will transfer to Core DACC once Core FBMC is live
- At this moment, CWE will enter into a parallel approach in order to facilitate a potential Rollback from Core to CWE during the 6 weeks Rollback period. The parallel approach allows the rapid restoration to CWE DA operational process and data in case needed
- This approach, running in the background, has been designed by CWE TSOs and NEMOs in alignment with the Core project
- For the Intraday timeframe CWE TSOs will keep in place a common tooling for aligning on bilateral ID capacity Increases/Decreases in line with the provisions for the transitional period in the Core ID CCM

CWE governance structure after Core DA go-live

- Existing CWE working structures will be dissolved
- For rare cases where a need for CWE related discussions may arise, it has been agreed to cover the future CWE TSO governance under the Core umbrella

Stakeholder Management

- CWE stakeholder management and alignment with NRAs and MPs will be handled under the Core umbrella after Core DA go-live. This will be done via dedicated ad-hoc slots within Core IG or Core CG meetings, if necessary
- CWE Utility Tool will be maintained, without any further updates after Core DA go-live, until 1 year after Core DA go-live allowing MPs to download and store relevant data
- CWE Q&A Forum on JAO will be decommissioned after the end of the Rollback period. MPs can ask their questions via the Core Q&A Forum and Core Q&A Forum admin will make sure to coordinate the answers for CWE-only questions
- CWE sections on JAO website will not be updated anymore after Core DA go-live. MPs are kindly asked to consult the relevant Core sections on JAO

Project closure

• CWE project closure follows shortly after the six-week Rollback period, plus an additional two weeks of Grace period
