
JAO Introduces Access Parameters to Ensure Fair Usage and Enhanced Data Availability

Luxembourg, October 2025, 1st – The Joint Allocation Office (JAO) is introducing new access parameters within its Publication Tool (PuTo) to ensure equitable access and maintain high-quality service for all users.

As the Publication Tool continues to expand, these measures are designed to maintain optimal performance and system stability. A rate limit of 100 requests per minute per user or IP address will be applied, and default responses will include up to two business days of data, with historical data remaining fully accessible using date and time filters.

To optimize data synchronization, users are encouraged to leverage the monitoring and metadata API endpoints to check data freshness before performing large requests, enabling more efficient and timely data retrieval
